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State renewable portfolio standards (RPS), clean energy standards (CES), and several types of de-carbonization measures currently exist in 30-plus U.S. states, more than 130 cities and over 300 businesses. Moreover, some 60 utilities have made voluntary pledges to provide zero or near zero carbon energy by mid-century.

The program will also provide electric, gas and long-term resource planning professionals and regulators with specific tools to fashion IRPs that deliver more accurate perspectives and greater insight into uncertainty and risk. A companion workshop will provide IRP, and other utility staff involved in the administration of competitive renewable procurement: 1) advanced planning and resource procurement strategies for clean energy systems, and 2) best practices and tools to strategically prepare, design, and respond to RFO/RFPs that obtain optimal results.
