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In this course, attendees will learn the fundamentals of the Natural Gas Liquids (NGL) and Petrochemical (PetChem) industries and markets, and the effect of the US Oil and Shale Revolution and the COVID-19 pandemic on each. The course is designed both non-technical and technical industry participants who need a basic overview of how the NGL and PetChem markets work.

Throughout a day and a half, you will come to understand the interaction between the NGL and PetChem supply chains, factors that affect markets and prices, and national and global market trends that may affect investments in NGL and PetChem projects.

The end goal of the course is for attendees to feel comfortable having in-depth conversations with more experienced people in the industry, therefore making it easier to engage in NGL and PetChem project and market discussions.



LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Review fundamentals of Natural Gas Liquids, including sources, uses, and units
- Grasp the NGL supply chain as it pertains to natural gas and to oil refineries (i.e. treatment, processing, production, separation, blending, etc.)
- Explain NGL infrastructure, pipelines, and storage, as well as other NGL transportation (water, rail, truck)
- Recognize NGL project costs in regard to processing, fractionators, and export terminals
- Discuss the fundamentals of the Petrochemical industry in terms of processes and equipment, markets, and exports
- Distinguish the types of petrochemicals and their uses
- Dissect global market trends of various petrochemicals
