Investment analysts have signaled in recent years a preference for electric utility investment in rate regulated activities, including transmission and distribution. Meanwhile, FERC’s Order No. 1000 reforms sought to create new opportunities for utilities and other developers to compete for regionally planned transmission projects.

This course will provide attendees with a review of FERC’s regulation of transmission-owning utilities and a working knowledge of cost-of-service rates for transmission. Attendees will learn how to construct a revenue requirement and calculate transmission rates from utility books and records using FERC’s cost of service statements or a formula rate, and will learn about the latest developments in FERC ratemaking policy and precedent on hot button issues such as ROE and tax reform.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Gain working knowledge of FERC’s regulation of electric utilities under Part II of the Federal Power Act
- Gain familiarity with FERC’s Uniform System of Accounts
- Discuss how to construct a transmission revenue requirement and transmission rates based on utility accounting records, including rate base, rate of return, depreciation, expenses, and taxes
- Identify how to populate and true-up a formula rate template
- Discuss how to estimate the return on equity using FERC’s evolving methodology
- Review recent FERC ratemaking developments in areas such as ROE, income taxes, and incentive rates
