The initial building block for any renewable energy or energy storage project is the land control instrument between renewable developer and landowner. There are many land agreements that can be used to obtain land control, with the most commonly used being the lease agreement. This course addresses the variety of land control documents that can be used, considerations for choosing which agreement to use, and will take an in-depth look at land lease agreements specifically. The course also will highlight how land control agreements interplay with survey and title insurance coverage, and will discuss other agreements related to land control and curing title issues such as crossing agreements, surface waivers, among others.
